PASTORAL CARE MINISTRIES

Active Ministries of Christian Life Center

Small Group Ministry

Ministry Purpose:

- To create community within the membership of Christian Life Center.
- To assimilate new members quickly into the church family.
- To provide a caring support system for all church members.
- To provide the opportunity to evangelize in our neighborhoods, workplaces, etc.

Areas of Involvement:

1. Zip Code Fellowship Groups:
 - Small groups that are put together according to geographical location.
 - “Open” groups – all members and friends are welcome to attend regardless of age or department.
 - To help evangelize neighborhoods where meetings are held.
 - Leadership positions available: small group leader and small group apprentice.
2. Common Interest Fellowship Groups:
 - Small groups that are put together according to a common interest (i.e. workplace, hobby, activity, personal interest, life-season).
 - Many of these groups are built within a current ministry department (i.e. youth, young adult, family ministries, singles, etc.).
 - To help evangelize workplaces where meetings are held.
3. Target Groups:
 - Small groups that are put together according to a specific need.
 - These groups run for a 12-week cycle only.
 - Groups (i.g. The Living Water Ministry, Freedom Ministry, etc.) may include drug and alcohol recovery, total emotional healing, crisis marriages made whole, etc.
 - The goal of these groups is to lead people to healing and deliverance.
 - Leadership positions available: small group leader and small group apprentice.

Requirements for Involvement:

New CLC Member

- Must have completed the Membership Class.
- Must believe and abide by doctrines of Scripture held by Christian Life Center.
- Must be faithful in church attendance and in financial support (tithes and offerings).
- Must be submissive to the authority of the Pastor and Department Head.
- Must be able to attend services and related meetings when your involvement requires it.
- Must complete all required reporting and documentation.
- Must complete training class for group leaders

Kingdom Kids – Children’s Ministry

Ministry Purpose:

The purpose of Kingdom Kids is to minister to children of all ages through quality Christian education and age-appropriate activities. It is the long-term goal of this ministry to build influential Christian leaders out of our children.

Areas of Involvement:

1. Occasionally teacher and/or assistant positions are available for the three major divisions:
 - King’s Kids classes on Wednesday nights and Sunday Jam services are for kids from grades 1-5.
 - Registration Team to assist in taking roll at each service.
 - Little Lights Division for kids in Kindergarten and Pre-Kindergarten on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings.
 - Tiny Tots staff to help with the nursery for children 0-4 during all services.

- Must be submissive to the Pastor and Department Head.
- Must be able to attend planning meetings that involve your participation.
- Must be faithful in church attendance and in financial support (tithes and offerings).

Acts-Twenty9 – Youth

Ministry Purpose:

- To minister to the spiritual needs of Young People, grades 6-12.
- To instruct youth in the foundational doctrines found in the Word of God.
- To provide a Christ-centered community where students can grow as well as to create friendships with other like-minded youth through programs such as weekly services and small core groups.
- To teach students the importance of seeking after the God’s will in their daily lives.
- To care for, instruct, and integrate new members into the established Christ-centered community.
- To evangelize the lost and convert the unsaved through proactive and aggressive outreach, which includes door knocking, street services, and one-on-one witnessing.

Areas of Involvement:

1. Small Group Leaders:
 - Leaders are expected to establish a “mini family” with 10-12 students in which discussions are held, caring is shown, and spiritual growth is nurtured.
 - Meet once a month with students at home or a location of the leader’s choice.
 - Attend two Captain’s meetings monthly with Acts-Twenty9 staff.
 - Follow-up and communicate with students in core group who are in spiritual decline.
 - Attend all youth services and youth activities.
2. EMT – Evangelism Ministry Team:
 - Participate and help plan evangelistic events for Acts-Twenty9.
 - Work with and attend all meetings held by EMT leader.
 - Take part in the carrying out of plans created by EMT.
3. Genesis – New Believers of Acts-Twenty9
 - Greet visitors and new members upon entering the premises.
 - Caring for students growing in the faith through postcards, calling, and personal visits.
 - Teaching and participating in Walking with God classes held bi-monthly during youth service.
 - Attend all Genesis staff meetings.
 - Attend youth services.
4. Parent Team:
 - Help secure the premises before and after Wednesday night youth services.
 - Act as a Support Team to Acts-Twenty9 staff and leadership.
 - Participate in fundraisers.
 - Communicate with youth in need of counsel.
 - Give a parental perspective to the staff of Acts-Twenty9.
5. ECHO – Evangelistic service of Acts-Twenty9 that includes drama, games, and special music and is held the first Wednesday of every third month.
 - Help with the planning of the ECHO service and attend all meetings.
 - Offer to act in planned dramas.

- Assist in lighting, music, production, and videoing of dramas.

Requirements for Involvement for Leaders and Team Members:

New CLC Member

- Must have completed the Membership Class.
- Must believe and abide by the doctrines of Scripture as held by Christian Life Center and be Born Again of Water and Spirit according to Acts 2:28.
- Must be faithful in attendance to church, in youth services, and in financial support (tithes and offerings).
- Must be submissive to the authority of the Pastor and Department Head.
- Must be able to attend Acts-Twenty9 services and related meetings when your involvement requires it.
- When involved in Acts-Twenty9, must be in the gym prayer room 30 minutes before start of service.
- Must have a love, burden, and genuine passion for young people.
